About Arabische Philologien im Blickwechsel/

نحو دراسات عربية برؤى متعددة

Initiated in 2013, the bilingual summer school program pursues a twofold agenda: to facilitate the exchange of perspectives and experiences between young and established scholars based in Europe and the Arab world, and to foster the use of Arabic as an academic language in Arabic Studies at European universities.

PhD students and postdocs from European and Arab universities are given the opportunity to present their research in an international context, discuss pioneering approaches to Arabic philology, literature, and culture, and actively practice the academic language they are less versed in (Arabic or English).

The summer school program thus supports transcultural knowledge production, offering a forum for academic self-reflection and linguistic, cultural, and scientific exchange, and creating bilingual teaching and learning communities aimed at extending lasting ties between individual scholars and academic institutions in both regions.

About the Arab-German Young Academy of Sciences and Humanities (AGYA)

AGYA is based at the Berlin-Brandenburg Academy of Sciences and Humanities (BBAW) and at the Academy of Scientific Research and Technology (ASRT) in Egypt. It was established in 2013 as the first bilateral young academy worldwide. AGYA promotes research cooperation among outstanding early-career researchers (3–10 year after PhD) from all disciplines who are affiliated with a research institution in Germany or in any Arab country.

The academy supports the innovative projects of its members in various fields of research, science policy, and education. More than 60 members – in equal number Arab and German scholars – realize joint projects and initiatives on topics such as Arab and German Education; Common Heritage and Common Challenges; Energy, Water and Environment; Health and Society; Transformation; and Innovation. With members and alumnae/i in 18 Arab countries and Germany, AGYA promotes Arab-German research exchange and supports North-South-South cooperation.

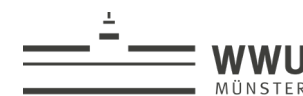
